# Range Re-opening: May 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020

### Shooters Procedures for Range Use During the Covid 19 Restrictions

The Club has instigated precautions, in addition to the already well-established general safety procedures, to mitigate the risk of exposure to the Covid 19 virus for shooters whilst at the Range.

As a quick reminder of existing procedures, you should comply with our General Regulations on safety. Both flags **MUST** be in place during shooting, and the gate **MUST** be locked.

In addition, to comply with additional procedures during Covid 19 restrictions:

- Wash your hands regularly and bring your own sanitiser or protective gloves. Sanitiser will be provided by the signing in register.
- Bring your own pen to sign in with
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue
- Sanitise surfaces and equipment that are touched/handled regularly
- Do not share food or drink
- Bring your FAC with you, in case of police checks.

**If you are feeling unwell or have Covid 19 symptoms please do not visit the Chipping Norton Range, no matter how mild the symptoms. If you are displaying symptoms yourself you must isolate for 7 days. If you are sharing a household with someone who is displaying symptoms you must isolate for 14 days.**

### Range Booking Procedure

1. All range use **MUST** be pre-booked online. It is strongly advised that you ask a friend for help if you do not have access to the internet.

Range bookings will be by the half-day and each session must be attributed to an individual, with all other participants listed.

- Only the named individuals will be permitted to shoot.
- Shooters who fail to arrive at the allocated time may not be permitted to shoot.
- Random Membership and SCC checks may be carried out on the range.

Note that no more than six people may be present on the range at any time, following government guidance for outdoor activities from the 1st of June 2020.

2. To book a time slot online (either morning or afternoon), go to <https://cnrpc.org/?p=265> and enter the Password, which for security will be sent to you via post / separate mail.
3. On arrival at the start of your allocated time you must sign on to the range in the usual way, using hand sanitiser before doing so.
4. Social distancing between shooters / those waiting to shoot of 2m / 6 feet is to be observed AT ALL TIMES. Please ensure you observe the 2m separation rule whilst you are waiting to shoot. Do not share personal equipment.
5. At the end of your allocated time please vacate the firing point promptly, collect all personal equipment

**Once your allotted time is over and you are clear of the firing point & waiting area, please leave the range as quickly as possible.**
